### ***Christ Chapel***

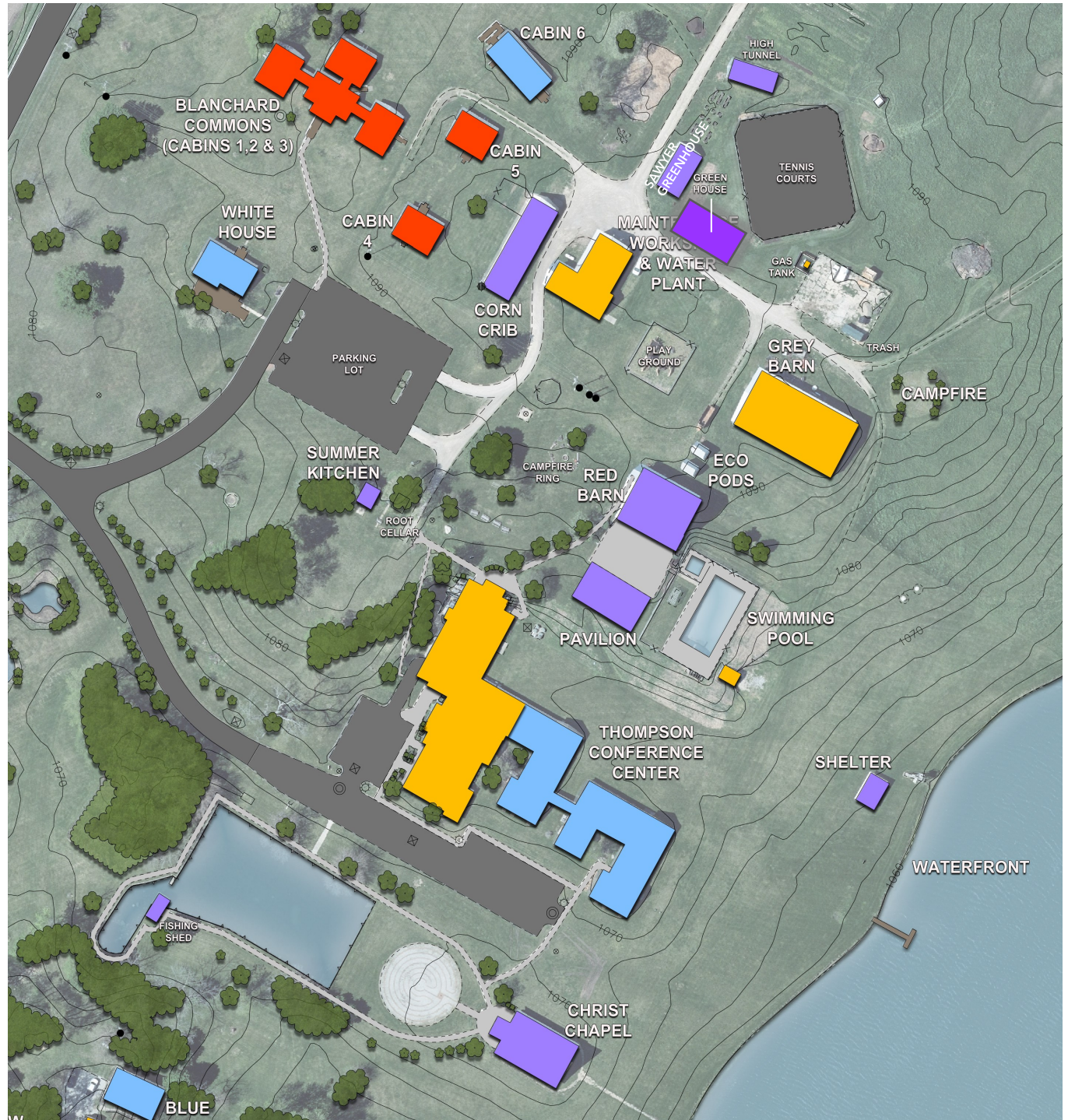
Built in 1998, a sacred space for campers and guests.

## **Lake Leo**

Features a grass walking path around the lake and a large stone structure on the peninsula that was once a watering trough for cattle.

## **The Woodlands**

70-acres of woodlands that include grass walking paths. Two vernal pools and a variety of native trees provide valued eco-systems.

We host over 15 beehives north of the lake, just off the gravel drive. They are fun to see, but please stay at least 20 feet away, or ouch! Bees are a vital pollinator for our vegetables and flowers.
