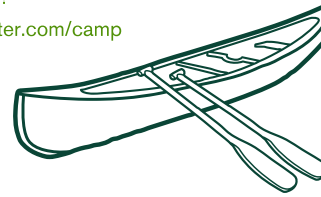
## Choose Ur Own Adventure Camp for Grown-Ups
